



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED RULE

The Hemphill County Underground Water Conservation District (“District”) will hold a public hearing on the District’s adoption of Proposed Rule 9.217. The purpose of this hearing is to provide interested members of the public with the opportunity to appear and provide oral or written comments to the District related to the Proposed Rule. The District proposes amending its rules to add Proposed Rule 9.217 (Petition for Rulemaking) in order to comply with 2023 Legislative amendments to Chapter 36, Texas Water Code. Proposed Rule 9.217 authorizes persons with a real property interest in groundwater in the District to petition for the adoption or modification of a district rule and establishes the procedures for the filing and consideration of such a petition.

Any person may appear in person, or by authorized representative, at the public hearing on Proposed Rule 9.217, and may provide oral comment or written comment. The District will accept written comments on Proposed Rule 9.217 no later than the close of the public hearing. Written comments must be filed by any of the following methods: (1) by mail to the District’s mailing address P.O. Box 1142, Canadian, Texas 79014; (2) by hand delivery to the District’s physical address 211 N 2nd. Street Canadian, Texas 79014; or (3) by hand delivery to the presiding officer at the public hearing.
